Job Title: Principal Faculty, Physician Assistant Program

Job Summary:

The Physician Assistant Studies Program at Drury University invites applicants to apply for a clinical-track 12-month principal faculty position at the rank of assistant/associate professor. Start date for this position is December 19, 2021.

The University seeks innovative faculty with strong self-initiative, organizational skills, interpersonal communication skills, and collaborative work ethic. Principal faculty will report directly to the Physician Assistant Program Director, and must be team oriented and possess excellent communication and problem-solving abilities. Principal faculty will be responsible for collaborative efforts in planning, evaluating, and coordinating the development and implementation of the Physician Assistant Studies Program.

Duties/Responsibilities:

- Student instruction, evaluation, academic advising, and remediation/reassessment efforts
- Serve as course director for assigned courses of the didactic year
- Participation in laboratory session and small group interactive sessions
- Participation in the organization, administration, continuous review and analysis in the accreditation process of the Physician Assistant Program. This includes applying for, achieving, and maintaining ARC-PA accreditation.
- Participation in implementing, coordinating, and evaluating the program's curriculum on a continuous basis
- Participation in the admissions process which consists of recruitment, interviewing, and selection of students for incoming cohort
- Maintain active physician assistant license

Required Skills/Abilities:

- Instructional and presentation skills
- Excellent English-language written and verbal communication skills
- Ability to work independently and as a member of a team
- Ability to interface with students, faculty, and staff

Education and Experience:

- Master's level Physician Assistant degree from an ARC-PA accredited school
- Minimum of three years of experience in a clinical practice setting as a physician assistant.

Required License/Registration/Certification

- Applicants must have a current NCCPA certification as a physician assistant
- Eligibility for licensure as a physician assistant in Missouri or currently licensed in Missouri
